Currently, women hold 17 per cent of on-site positions at the mine, including Yukon women like **Brianne Puckett**, **Starr Hanson** and **Chelsey Goodman**.

Brianne has been with Victoria at the Eagle Gold Mine since May 2019 and is an ADR Operator. One of her regular tasks involves helping prepare and pour the mine's gold doré bars. "I enjoy the people I work with and the diversity of tasks my role involves," says Brianne. "There is always something new to learn, which keeps things interesting."

### ABOUT VICTORIA GOLD & THE EAGLE GOLD MINE

The Eagle Gold Mine, now in production, is part of Victoria's 100-per cent-owned Dublin Gulch Property located approximately 375 kilometres north of Whitehorse and 85 kilometres north, northeast of the Village of Mayo within the traditional territory of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun. The property is accessible by road year-round and is connected to Yukon Energy Corp's electrical grid. The mine will be a significant contributor to Yukon employing 350 to 400 people.
