#LYTTONSTRONG FUNDRAISER

In early June, Victoria Gold was proud to participate in the #LyttonStrong fundraiser to help the residents and businesses of Lytton, BC re-build their outdoor community pool after a wildfire devastated their town last summer.

#LyttonStrong raised over \$150,000 through an online silent auction featuring 70 items; including two Explore Yukon packages donated by Victoria Gold.

The fundraiser, which culminated on June 12, well surpassed organizers' original fundraising target of \$125,000.

ABOUT VICTORIA GOLD & THE EAGLE GOLD MINE

The Eagle Gold Mine is situated within Victoria Gold's 100 per cent-owned Dublin Gulch Property located approximately 375 kilometres north of Whitehorse and 85 kilometres north, northeast of the Village of Mayo within the traditional territory of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun. The property is accessible by road year-round and is connected to Yukon Energy Corp's electrical grid. The mine is a significant contributor to the Yukon economy employing 350-400 people.
